Scoop has just woken up and needs a groom. Can you help him by sorting the grooming instructions into the correct order?

- 1 Brush mane using body brush, mane brush or fingers
- 2 Use the rubber curry comb in circular motions over horse's body to loosen dry skin/ sweat
- 3 Pick the horse's hooves out with the hoof pick – remember to pick from heel to toe
- 4 Brush through the tail with a body brush or your fingers
- 5 Brush the horse's body with the body brush every few strokes use the metal curry comb to clean the body brush
- 6 Put the headcollar on the horse and clip lead rope to the headcollar. Tie lead rope to a safety loop using a quick release
- 7 Use the dandy brush to remove any excess mud – only use on unclipped areas
- 8 To groom the horse's head, untie the knot in the lead rope, slide headcollar back around his neck. Brush his face gently with the body brush

## Answers

Extra items of grooming kit = 1 = Tail Bandage, 2 = Water Brush, 3 = Stable Rubber

Grooming procedure = 1<sup>st</sup> = 6, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 3, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 7, 4<sup>th</sup> = 2, 5<sup>th</sup> = 5, 6<sup>th</sup> = 1, 7<sup>th</sup> = 4, 8<sup>th</sup> = 8

Feeds = 1 = Horse & Pony Nuts, 2 = Hay, 3 = Coarse Mix
